<b>Queen's Platinum Jubilee – Thu 26 May</b>	<p>Aiden explained that the school are planning to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee on Thursday 26 May. The plan is to do something similar to the Queen's 90<sup>th</sup> birthday celebration – with some food outside (weather permitting) and some activities in the hall. Each year will be looking at a decade of the Queen's life. It was agreed that a drink e.g. fruit shoot, little cake and snack would suffice.</p> <p>Louise offered to contact Kelly, the Community Champion at Morrisons, to see if they'd be able to donate anything e.g. kids lunch boxes, fruits shoots. Could also approach other local businesses such as McDonalds or Aldi.</p> <p>Louise also offered to contact Adkins Bakery to see if they could contribute any cakes/ cookies (nut free).</p> <p>Need to get dietary requirements from office for numbers of gluten free, dairy free etc.</p> <p>Each class is making their own bunting for their table but any extra bunting any one has would be good. Lee offered to lend some outdoor bunting.</p> <p>Need a team of volunteers on the morning of 26 May or day before to fill all the boxes.</p>
