Free School Meal Eligibility

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Healthy school food has obvious health benefits and can help pupils establish healthy habits for life. Healthy school food can also help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earner income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-Based Jobseeker's allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16190

There is currently a temporary extension of free school meals eligibility for Children of those who have no recourse to public funds. These groups include, but may not be limited to children of:

- Zambrano carers
- Families who have no recourse to public funds with a right to remain in the UK on grounds of private and family life under Article 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights
- Families receiving support under Section 17 of the Children Act 1989 who are also subject to a no recourse to public funds restriction
- A subset of failed asylum seekers supported under Section 4 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Chen carers
- Families holding a BN (O) passport (<u>https://www.gov.uk/british-national-overseas-bno-visa</u>)
- Spousal visa holders
- Work visa holders
- Student visa holders
- Those with no immigration status

Please note the maximum income threshold differs based on your location and the number of children that your family has.

Registering for free school meals could also raise extra money for school to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.
